Florida State Christian Academy's 1st Annual Read A Thon

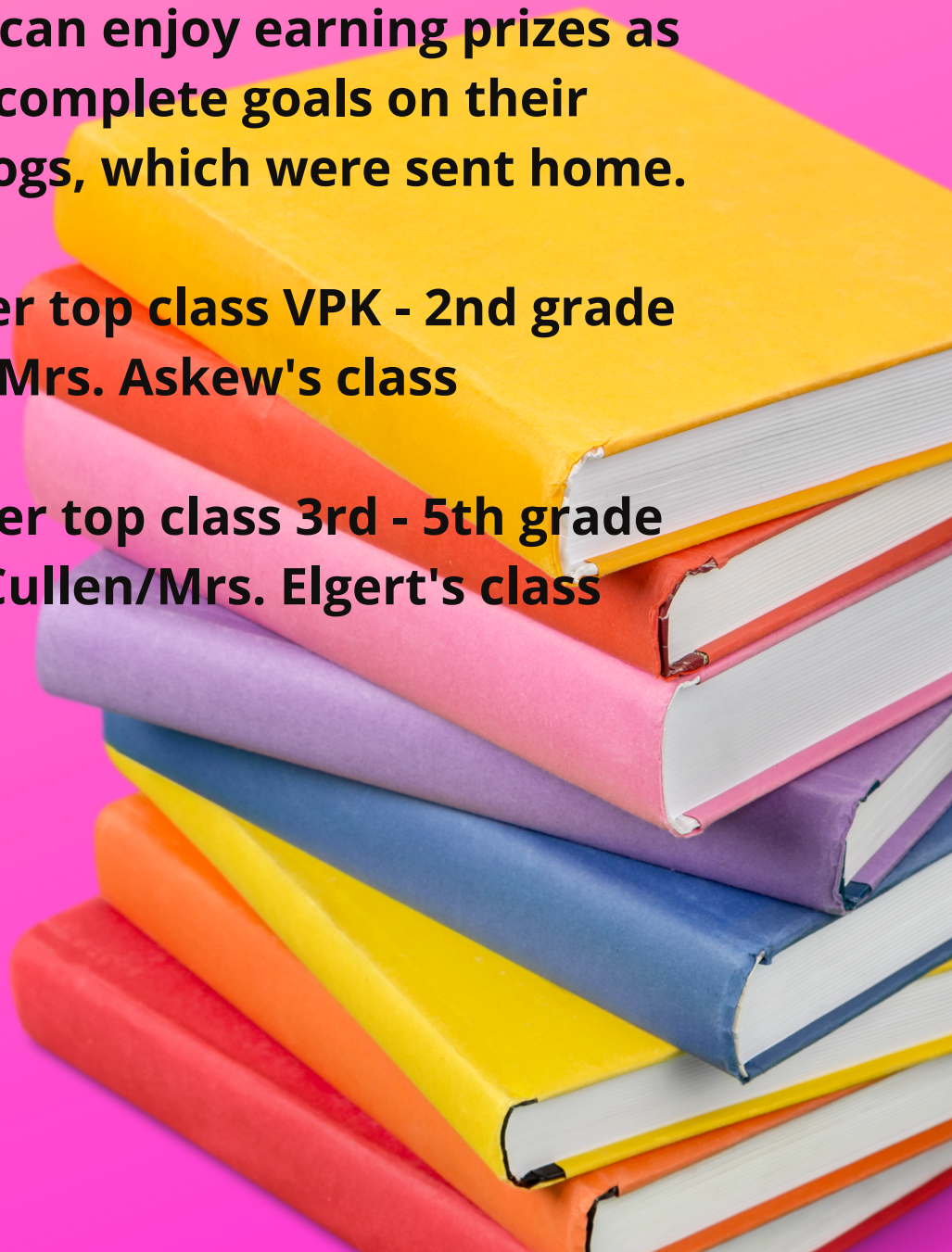
**Our first annual VPK - 5th Grade reading contest began

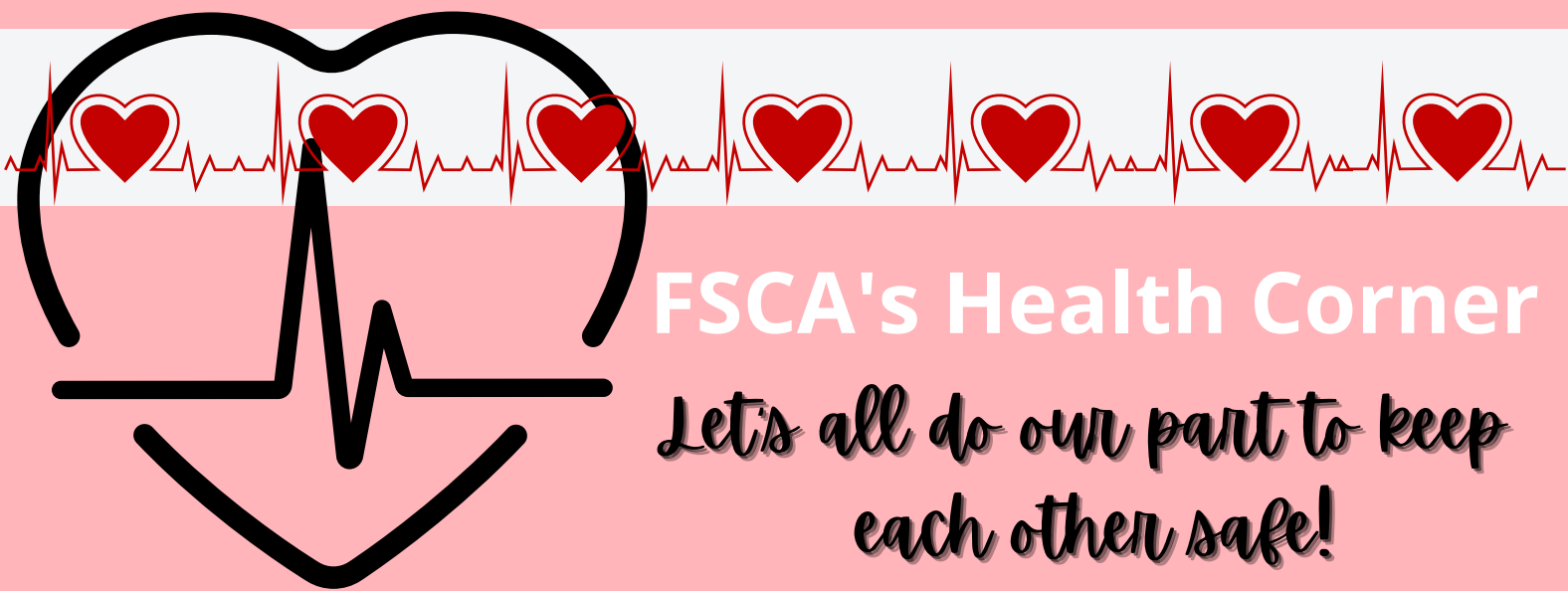

A Morning Checklist Before Coming To School

Does your child have any of the following new or worsening symptoms:

- Temperature over 100.3
- A persistent cough
- Difficulty breathing
- Loss of Taste or Smell
- Sore throat or painful swallowing
- Stuffy or Runny nose
- Headache
- Nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea
- Feeling unwell, muscle aches or feeling
